RESOLUTION NUMBER 16-2

A Resolution Adopting an Encroachment Permit Form and Fee

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Golden West Community Services District (the "District") believes that establishing standards and regulations for installation, maintenance and repair of culverts and driveways within the boundaries of roadway easements dedicated to the County and maintained by the District and that issuing encroachment permits to allow members of the public to access such roadways for such purposes/will protect against deterioration of District roadways from excessive water drainage or runoff; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 5, Sections 3 and 4 define and describe encroachment as applied to District roads; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 5, Section 4.030 authorizes the Board to establish a fee for reviewing the permit application and conducting the necessary inspections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Golden West Community Services District adopts the Encroachment Permit form and fee shown in Attachment 1.




