We hereby submit specifications and estimates for the following work:

- 1) Remove the existing blacktop approach to install a new culvert. Replace approximately 216 sq. ft., 12' x 18', with 2.5" of 1/2" compacted blacktop over the existing base rock.
- 2) Replace the existing culvert with a twenty foot section of new 18" ADS double wall pipe.
- 3) Remove and reset the existing mail box.
- 4) Clean the roadside ditch above the culvert thirty feet +/- below the ditch to the intersection of Oak Ridge Circle South. Spoils will be dumped at the Association's dump site. Blacktop will be hauled off with the old culvert.

Notes: Prevailing wages and traffic control are figured in the proposal.

Exclusions: Compaction testing, sealing the blacktop.


