We hereby submit specifications and estimates for the following work:

on approximately 300 ln. ft. of road-side shoulder.

- 1) Remove the existing material to a depth of 6.5". The spoils to be dumped on a Golden West CSD lot. Place 4" of 3/4" recycled base rock. Place 2.5" of compacted 1/2" blacktop. The width varies from 11.5' to 6'.
- 2) Place approximately 300' of concrete curb.
- 3) Place metal bars on the existing grate of the drain inlet.
- 4) Place 100 double sided reflector markers as directed.

Lump Sum \$ 18,685.00

Exclusions: Hammering of rock refusal, soil or compaction testing, lowering the grade over the existing water line, lowering the water line, painting a new fog line, sealing the blacktop.

Note: Prevailing wages are figured for the job.



We hereby submit specifications and estimates for the following work: on three areas.

- 1) Ferrite Street--Work on the Existing Approach--  
Widen the south side approximately 3.5' at the widest spot. Sweep, reshape, and compact the existing base rock. Place 2.5" of compacted 1/2" blacktop on approximately 2,100 sq. ft. The pavement will stop 50' from the fog line. Raise one water box.  

Lump Sum \$ 6,300.00
- 2) Oak Ridge Circle South--Pave the Shoulder Area in Front of the Existing Mailboxes, Fire Hydrant, and Newspaper Boxes (approximately 60' x 6'-8')--  
Clean the existing blacktop. Pave the radius and 24' from the fog line to a width of 33'. Overlay this area with 1.5" of compacted 1/2" blacktop. The balance of the approach, 26' x 27', will have 2" of compacted 1/2" blacktop. The total area of pavement will be approximately 2,152 sq. ft.  

Lump Sum \$ 5,710.00
- 3) Oak Ridge Circle North--Starting at 25' from the Fog Line--  
Place 2.5" of compacted 1/2" blacktop over the existing base rock, approximately 25' x 22'.  

Lump Sum \$ 3,000.00

Note: The price is based on one move in and prevailing wages paid.  
Exclusions: Compaction testing, permits, sealing blacktop.

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
