We hereby submit specifications and estimates for the following work:

**level course and overlay.**

- 1) Clean approximately 9,000 sq. ft. of existing chip seal roadway.
- 2) Apply SS-1H tack oil.
- 3) Level, using 1/2" AC with 2.5 lbs. of fibers per ton, compacted into place.
- 4) Place an additional 2" of compacted 1/2" AC with 2.5 lbs. of fibers per ton. Tie into four driveways. Approx. 149 tons of asphalt will be used.

**Lump Sum \$ 22,681.00**

**Notes:** Prevailing wages are included. Fibers are used to help prevent cracking between the existing road surface and the new mat.

**Exclusions:** Any permits, or fees, compaction or soils testing, relocation or repair of any utilities, ditching, shoulder work, sealing, erosion control, anything not specifically described in the proposal.



**"NOTICE TO OWNER"**

Under the Mechanics' Lien Law (California Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1181 et seq.), any contractor, subcontractor, laborer, supplier or other person who helps to improve your property but is not paid for his work or supplies, has a right to enforce a claim against your property. This means that, after a court hearing, your property could be sold by a court officer and the proceeds of the sale used to satisfy the indebtedness.
