PROPOSED RESURFACING OF AMALGAM ST. 2016-May 14-AMALGAM ST. OVERLAY

Purpose— Amalgam St. has undergone many years of neglect and is in need of repair. There are three occupied homes along the street and has minimal daily traffic. The current surface approx. 50 ft. past the fog line at Crystal appears to be questionable at best due to large pot holes and degrading surface. The width of the road does vary due to ditch washout and vegetation overgrowth. This forces the residents to drive on a narrow section approx. 150 ft. from the main road.

Proposed Project—apply a compacted leveling course to the road surface and a finish surface of AC with a fiber material to reduce the possibility of cracking.

Time Frame—temperatures are rising to the benefit any roadwork at this time. The fiscal year of the G.W.C.S.D. is ending and there are funds available for small projects. The contractor is available to get this completed by early June and the District can move on to larger projects.
