As you may be aware, the Logtown Fire Safe Council has obtained two grants totaling about \$200k to construct an 85-acre, reduced fuels zone between Union Mine Rd. and Monitor Ridge. This work will take place over the next year and a half, and will require considerable effort on the part of the Fire Safe Council to execute all elements of the grants.

As I have undertaken to lead planning and execution of these grants, I find myself soon to be overwhelmed by community volunteer activities beyond my day job. Accordingly, I feel I must resign my position as Secretary of the Golden West Community Services District at the end of this year. In consideration of the short time of this notice, I will be happy to serve as Secretary for the District's December 2016 regular meeting, and to complete publication of that meeting's minutes, if that arrangement is amenable to the Board. I will also support my successor's transition to the position in any way I can be of help through the early part of 2017.

I have enjoyed serving as GWCSD Secretary for the past two years, and I have learned a great deal about the District, its workings and its politics. I encourage you and the other Directors to continue the present Board's drive toward greater service, productivity and transparency. The District's positive transformation over the past few years has been a joy to watch and experience, and I will urge the Board to continue driving that transformation forward from my future seat in the audience.
