

Minutes of March 16, 1988 - Regular Meeting Present: Spangler, Cosgrove, Miller, Humenick, Yonker

He reported that he wrote a letter to the owner stating as much. The owner disagreed with him. President Spangler stated he will write a letter to the owner stating our position on the matter. Secretary Yonker was instructed to file a Conflict of Interest Code with the County Office.

Secretary Yonker Reported a conversation he had with Supervisor Pat Lowe regarding the difficulty the district was having with the Sherriff's department enforcing parking regulations inthe district. The result was he recieved a phone call from Captain Brown inquiring as to what it was all about. He was referred to the meeting between our lawyer, the Sherriff's Department and the District Attorney and the resulting letter that was submitted to the District by the lawyer. Captain Brown stated he would get a copy of the letter from the lawyer.
